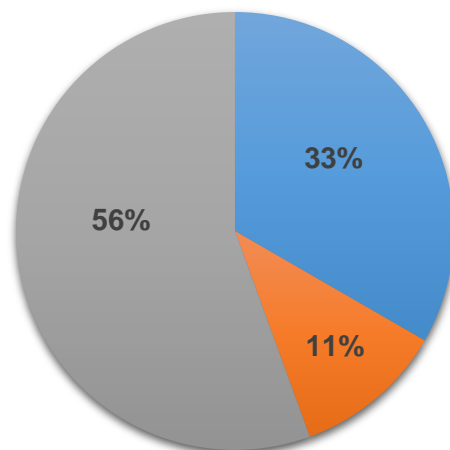

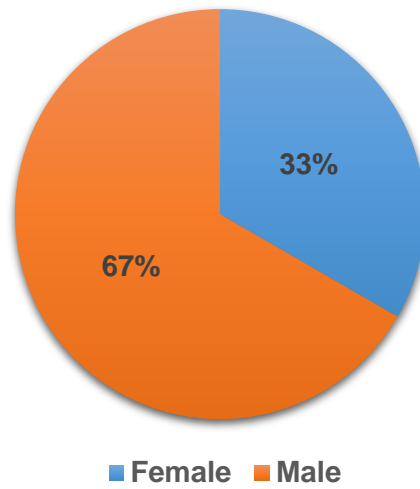

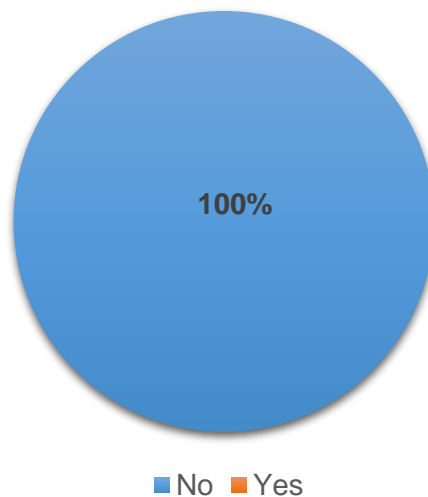

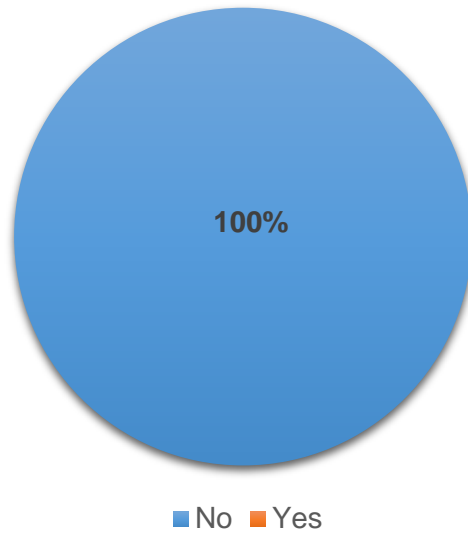

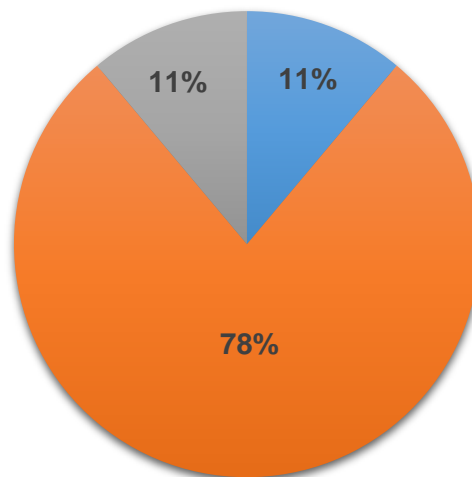
### 4. Disability. Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition in the Equality Act?



**5. Disability. Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?**

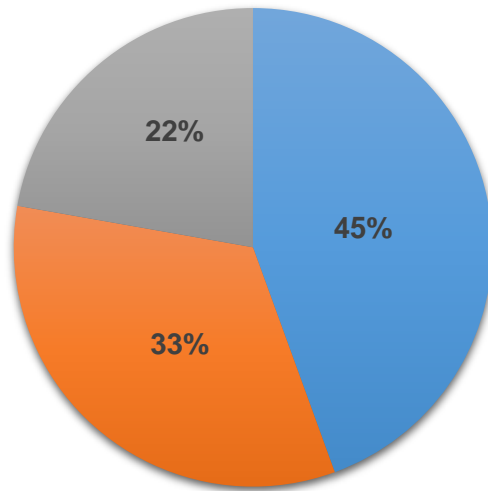


**6. Ethnic Group. What is your ethnic group?**



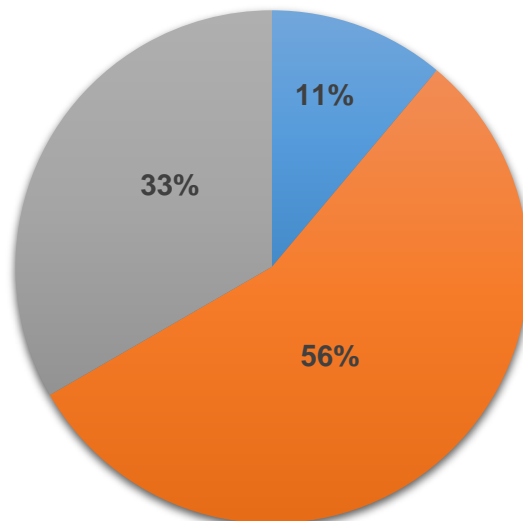

### 7. Religion or belief. What is your religion or belief?



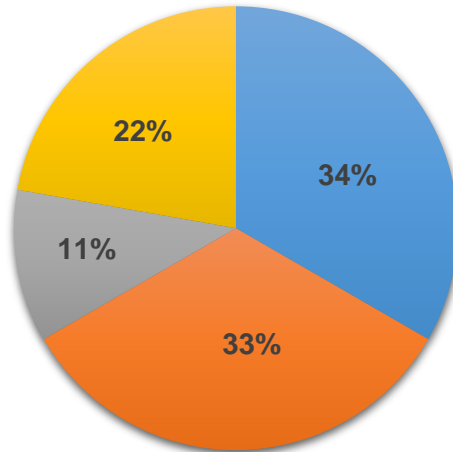

### 8. Sexual orientation. What is your sexual orientation?



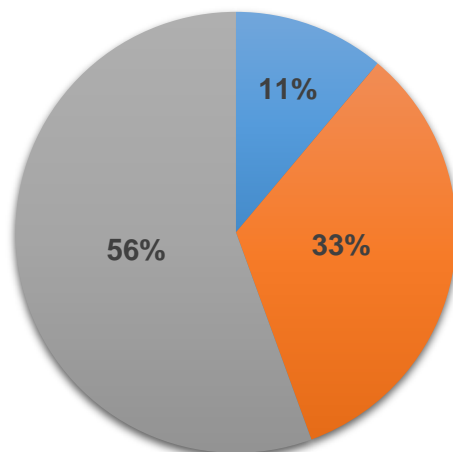

**9. Socio-economic background. If you went to University (to study a BA, BSc course or higher), were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?**



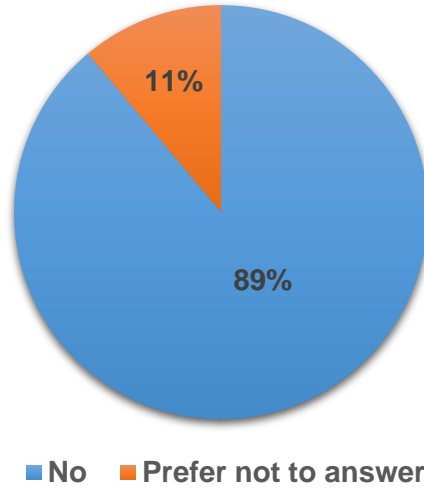
