£10 million Ponzi Scheme

13 December 2023

Burglary

Olivia Hagggar successfully prosecuted this individual for burglary of a quadbike. The offence was committed the day before the homicide of PC Andrew Harper, and came to light during the wider investigation.

R v DN [Highbury Youth Court] 2021

Conspiracy to commit robbery

Olivia Hagggar was instructed to represent a youth charged with conspiracy to commit robbery with two others. After consideration of the phone evidence, Olivia drafted a section 78 argument, which led to the Crown discontinuing proceedings against her client. Instructed by Edwards Duthie Shamash.

R v DS [Kingston Crown Court] 2020

Actual Bodily Harm

Olivia Hagggar represented a man charged with assaulting a Police Officer during the course of a foot chase, thereby occasioning her actual bodily harm. DS was unanimously acquitted after trial. Instructed by Freemans.

Operation Mowhawk [Croydon Crown Court] 2019

Conspiracy to commit fraud

Pauline Thompson led Olivia Hagggar in a conspiracy to commit fraud and associated money laundering. All ten defendants were convicted. Instructed by Croydon Trading Standards.

R v Dr V [GMC & Crown Court] 2019

Sexually Motivated Misconduct

The defendant doctor, having been acquitted of sexual assaults on a patient at the Crown Court (also represented by Sarah Forshaw QC), was to face similar allegations brought by the GMC. Miss Forshaw, assisted by Olivia Hagggar, was asked to represent him again at the full contested hearing which lasted 3 weeks. Once again, the complainant and other witnesses were cross-examined. The allegations were all found 'not proved' by the Tribunal. The Doctor has returned to full-time work. Instructed by BCL.
