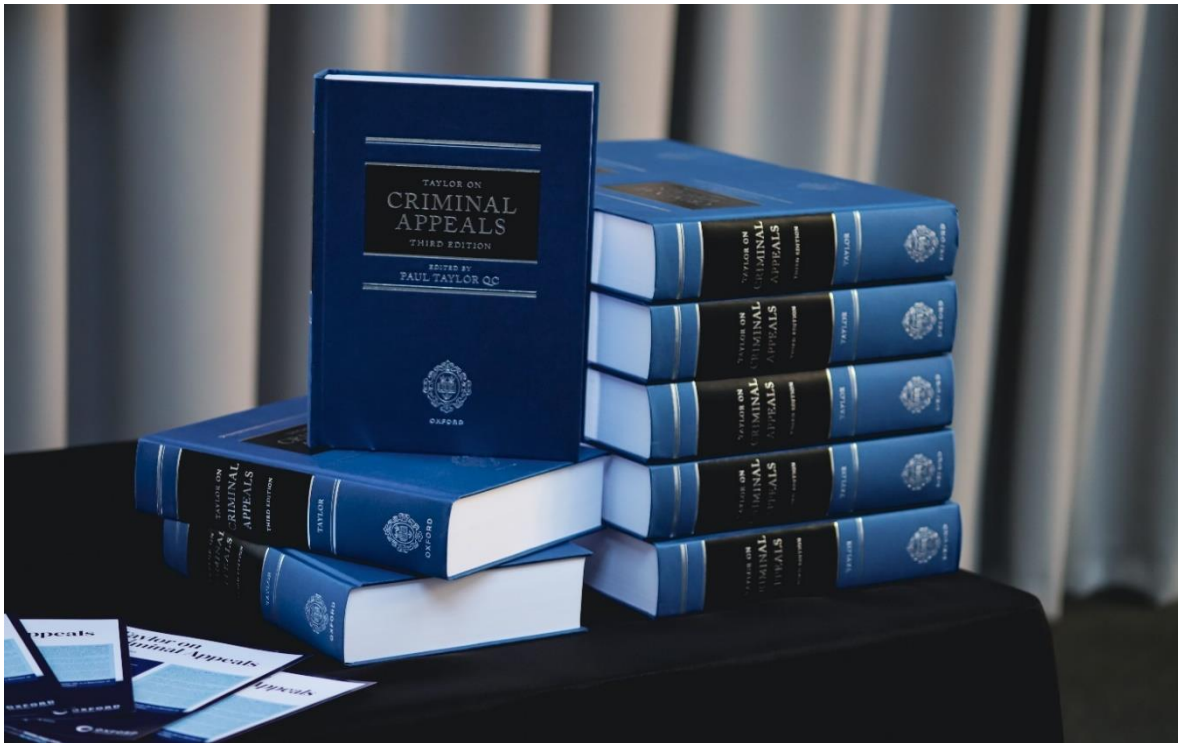


## TAYLOR ON CRIMINAL APPEALS (3<sup>rd</sup> Edition)



The book was written by a team headed by Paul Taylor KC as general editor. It is an essential tool for those confronted with a potential criminal appeal or judicial review, and provides a detailed guide to the practice and procedure.

The first two editions were cited variously in judgments of the House of Lords, Privy Council, Court of Appeal (Criminal Division), Court of Appeal in Northern Ireland, Final Court of Appeal in Hong Kong, Court of Appeal of New Zealand, High Court of Fiji, Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court, and Caribbean Court of Justice.

Lord Hodge, Deputy President of the Supreme Court, wrote in the foreword to the third edition:
